GRAND CLASS EXPANSION

The Grand Princess is the largest and most expensive cruise ship ever built, representing a \$450 million commitment by Princess to its Grand Class expansion program. By 2001, four additional superliners will have joined the renowned Love Boat fleet—Sea Princess in 1998, Ocean Princess in 1999 and two yet-to-be-named sister ships to Grand Princess in 2001. The Grand Class new buildings, which began with Sun Princess in 1995 and Dawn Princess in 1997, were the fruit of a total investment of over \$2.5 billion!

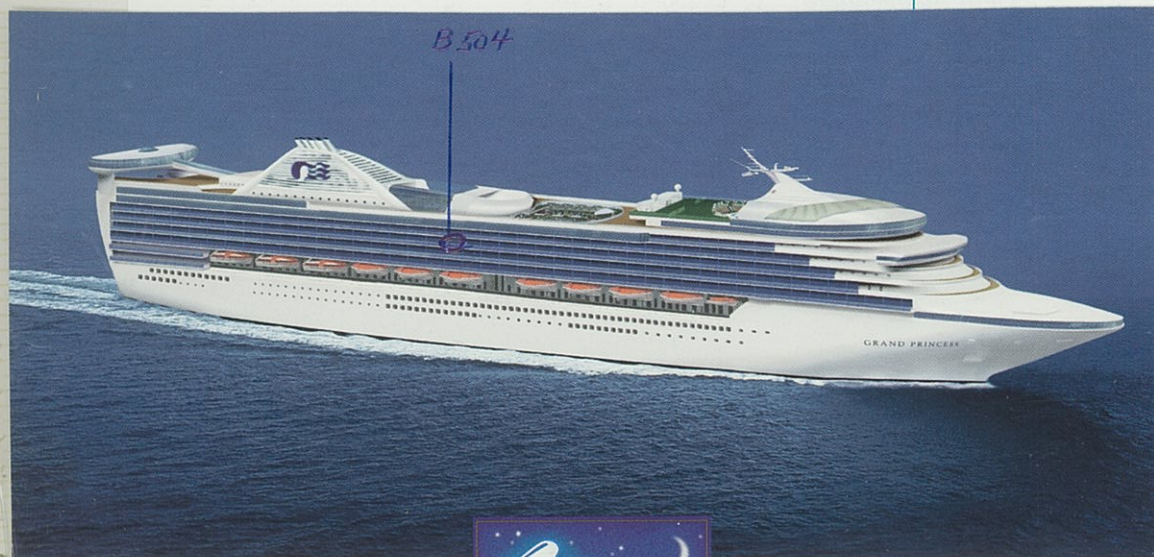

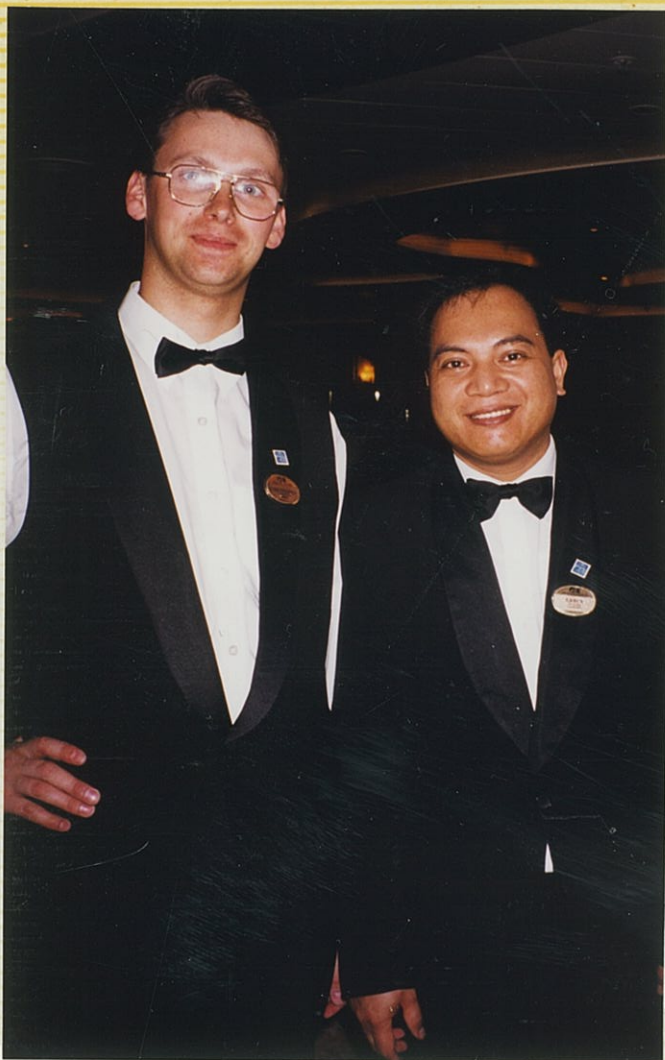

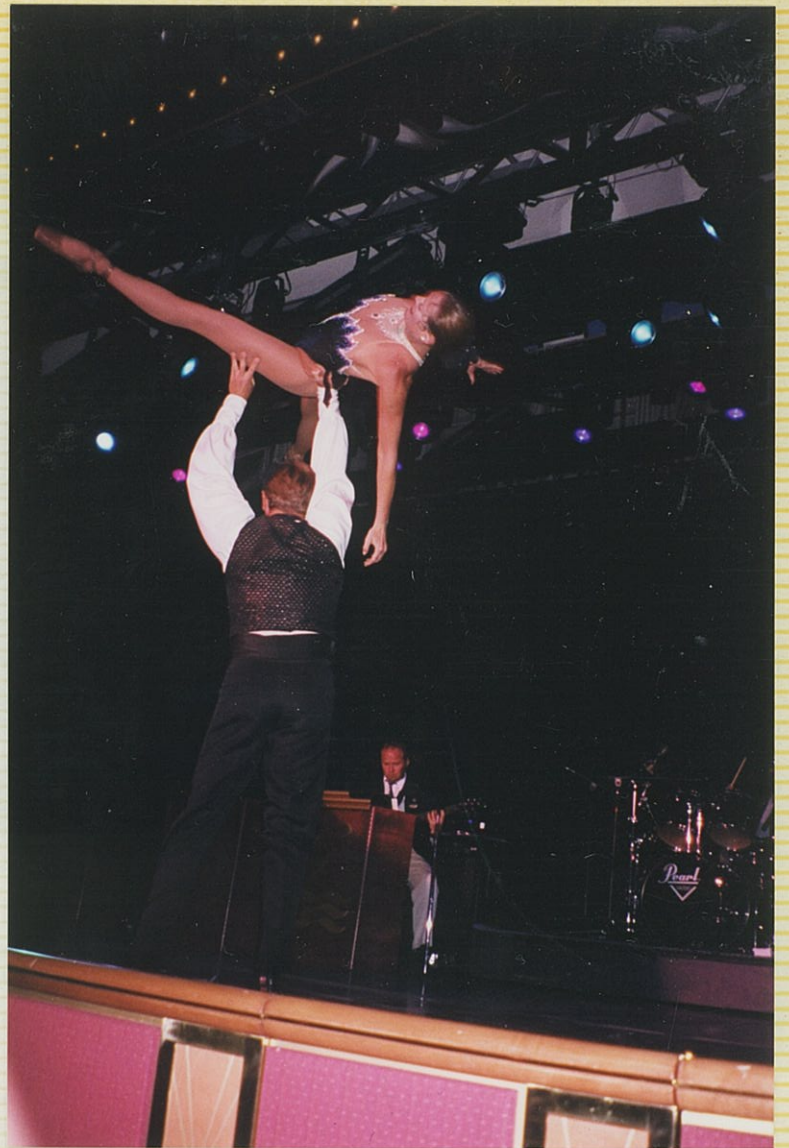
