USS UNDERWOOD (FFG 36) is the 29th ship of the OLIVER HAZARD PERRY class of Guided Missile Frigates and the first of the third generation of that class. UNDERWOOD has incorporated several new systems such as Integrated Naval Tactical Data System (NTDS), Satellite Communications and Navigation Systems, Integrated Electronics Warfare Detection Systems, and a third Command and Decision computer which allows for future Anti-Submarine Warfare improvements. The key to success in today's tactical environment is the ability to respond rapidly and effectively to any given situation. UNDERWOOD's systems are designed to meet these vital requirements. UNDERWOOD has been built primarily to provide in-depth protection for military and merchant shipping, amphibious task forces, and underway replenishment groups.

The Combat Systems new and innovative design integrates a computerized command and decision system with the ship's sensors and weapons. Three computers provide a rapid evaluation of potential threats detected by the ship's radars, sonar, and other sensors. Should the need arise surface-to-air and surface-to-surface missiles, a rapid fire 76MM gun, close in weapons system (CIWS), ASW torpedoes, and the embarked LAMPS III helicopters can quickly be employed to strike hostile targets or counter threats from aircraft, ships, or submarines.

The propulsion system is a computer controlled gas turbine power plant with engines similar to those found on the Air Force's C-5A strategic transport. The main engines can be "on the line" and ready in less than one-eighth the time required for a conventional steam propulsion plant.

In keeping with the minimum manning concept of the FFG-7 class, several labor saving devices have been installed to reduce the number of personnel required to man the ship. Also some improvements have been made in shipboard habitability such as lounge areas in each berthing space instead of one lounge for the entire ship.

Commander Andrew C. Beck II was born 10 March 1944 at Laconia, New Hampshire. He moved, at an early age, to St. Johnsbury, Vermont where he graduated from the St. Johnsbury Academy. Commander Beck entered the United States Naval Academy at Annapolis, Maryland in July 1962. Upon graduation in 1966, he was commissioned an Ensign in the US Navy and assigned as Gunnery Assistant in USS Philip (DD-498) homeported at Pearl Harbor, Hawaii. One year later, he became Combat Information Center Officer and served in that capacity until his reassignment to combat duty in Vietnam in August 1968. For thirteen months, Commander Beck was the Senior Patrol Officer for River Division 591 operating in the inland waters of The Republic of Vietnam from Cambodia to the Gulf of Tonkin. Following graduation from destroyer school in June 1970, Commander Beck became the first Engineer Officer in USS Bowen (FF-1079) homeported in Newport, Rhode Island. In October 1972, Commander Beck received orders to USS Marvin Shields (FF-1066) in San Diego, California, as Executive Officer where he served until August 1974. Commander Beck was then ordered to his first shore duty as a student at the Naval Postgraduate School in Monterey, California. He graduated with a Masters Degree in Mechanical Engineering in December 1976 and proceeded to the Bureau of Naval Personnel where he assumed duties as Assistant Lieutenant Commander Assignment Officer. He was detached in January 1979 and reported as Aide and Flag Secretary to Commander Cruiser-Destroyer Group FIVE. In June 1981, Commander Beck was ordered to attend the Prospective Commanding Officer Course at Newport, Rhode Island and the Senior Officer Ship Material Readiness Course at Idaho Falls, Idaho and ultimately as Commanding Officer, USS UNDERWOOD (FFG 36).

Commander Beck is authorized to wear the Bronze Star with Combat Distinguishing Device, the Combat Action Ribbon, the Vietnamese Staff Medal, First Order and other expeditionary, campaign and service awards. He is married to the former Jereldine Ellard Collins of Dover, New Hampshire. They have a daughter, Allison, and a son, Andrew III. The family resides in Bath, Maine.
